AUTHORIZED USES:

PRECISION SHOOTING

Competitive Benchrest, Load Testing, and Zeroing

Mon-Sat 9am to Dusk, Sun Noon to Dusk

SAFETY GLASSES AND EAR PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED ON ALL ORSA RANGES.

When moving to the line, ensure firearms are unloaded and cased or holstered.

Do not touch firearms if RANGE COLD lights are flashing.

1. TREAT ALL FIREARMS AS IF LOADED AT ALL TIMES.
2. KEEP MUZZLE POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION AT ALL TIMES.
3. KEEP FINGER OFF & AWAY FROM TRIGGER UNTIL ABSOLUTELY READY TO SHOOT.
4. KEEP FIREARM UNLOADED UNTIL READY TO SHOOT OR IF RANGE SAFETY LIGHTS ARE ON.
5. NEVER POINT ANY FIREARM AT ANYTHING YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO COMPLETELY DESTROY.
6. **DO NOT TOUCH YOUR FIREARM OR ANY OF ITS PARTS IF RANGE SAFETY LIGHTS ARE ON.**
7. FIRE AT THE TARGET IN FRONT OF YOUR POINT. DO NOT CROSS-FIRE.
8. DO NOT TOUCH YOUR FIREARM IF RANGE SAFETY LIGHTS ARE FLASHING.
9. NO 50 BMG OR ROUNDS BASED ON THE 50 BMG CARTRIDGE.
10. NO FULL AUTO OR TRIGGER ACTUATORS OF ANY KIND SIMULATING FULL-AUTO ARE ALLOWED.

AUTHORIZED Firearms and Ammunition

Centerfire and rimfire rifles, handguns,, muzzleloaders, shotguns with slugs only.

ABSOLUTELY NO 50 BMG ROUNDS OR ROUNDS BASED ON THE 50 BMG CARTRIDGE.

Range Safety Light System

PRIOR TO GOING DOWN RANGE:

CALL "CEASE FIRE – RANGE COLD"

1. MAKE ALL FIREARMS SAFE AND CLEAR WITH ACTIONS OPEN.
2. REMOVE MAGAZINES, SAFETY ON IF SO EQUIPPED, AND INSERT EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR.
3. TURN FLASHING LIGHTS ON.
4. **ABSOLUTELY NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS, MAGAZINES OR OTHER PARTS WHEN PERSONNEL ARE DOWN RANGE AND LIGHTS ARE ON.**

TO GO HOT

1. ENSURE ALL PERSONNEL ARE BEHIND FIRING LINE.
2. DON EYE AND EAR PROTECTION.
3. TURN FLASHING LIGHTS OFF, CALL "RANGE HOT".

Authorized Targets

ONLY PAPER TARGETS ON VINYL BACKERS BETWEEN THE UPRIGHTS AT 50, 100, 200 YDS.

NO AERIAL TARGETS

NO POLITICAL SIGNS

ANY TARGET ON THE GROUND IS PROHIBITED

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

ALWAYS clean up after yourself & others.

MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING THESE RULES AND FOR CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS. VIOLATORS CAN BE EXPELLED FROM ORSA AND PROSECUTED TO FULL EXTENT OF THE LAW.
